Professionalism:

They should conduct themselves in a manner that upholds the dignity of the charity, fostering trust and respect among stakeholders.

Compliance:

Adherence to all relevant laws, regulations, and best practices governing charitable organizations in Ireland is mandatory.

Conflict of Interest:

Any potential conflicts of interest must be disclosed and managed appropriately, avoiding any personal gain at the charity's expense.

Respect:

They must respect the rights, dignity, and worth of all individuals and communities served by the charity.

Collaboration:

Encourage a culture of teamwork, valuing the contributions of volunteers, staff, and fellow directors.

Continuous Improvement:

Commit to ongoing personal development and to enhancing the charity's effectiveness through innovative and efficient practices.
